The project

Oak Wood Secondary School is a passionate educational institution located in Nuneaton with 170 students. With a rich history spanning several decades, it has become a cornerstone of the local community.

Despite its positive reputation, technology-wise, Oak Wood was in need of a change. The staff of Oak Wood were utilising an old Alcatel phone system, with many of the handsets in an inadequate state. The IT team were reviewing the use of more cost-effective handsets to reduce their ongoing maintenance costs.

Additionally, the school wanted to page all handsets for emergency/lockdown incidents - an imperative factor in education today - and Alcatel had limited group sizes of 32 handsets. That's where we stepped in to help.

The solution

Focus Group installed a 3CX system in Oak Wood Secondary School's Hyper-V, offering OS and software support along with second-line fault assistance.

3CX is cost-effective, reliable, and scalable, handling multiple calls efficiently in an educational setting. We provided partial installation, guiding the team on handset configuration for self-installation and maintenance.

Additionally, our Bronze Remote support manages VM updates, and we recommended the free 3CX admin course for staff to handle daily changes.
